## Glenwood Exterior Maintenance Policy

- 1. Painting required
  - a. Blistering, pealing, fading, etc. on door, shutters, trim, decorative elements, or elsewhere on residence.
- 2. Materials missing or in need of repair
  - a. Siding, shutters, trim, decorative elements, or other item(s).
- 3. Garage doors
  - a. Dented, rusted, or otherwise damaged over 50% of area.
- 4. Dirt, mold, or other staining over 25% of any surface of the house.
- 5. Trash can storage
  - a. Not allowed in front of house.
  - b. If on side of house, needs privacy panel, planting, or other visual element to hide from curb view.
- 6. Roofing/shingles must be of consistent color and style, and in good condition.
- 7. Cars without license plate or current yearly tag, or with excessive rusting or other damage may not be kept in driveway.
- 8. Landscaping
  - a. Minimum of two trees, and six shrubs/bushes.
  - b. Plants may not block windows, lighting, paths, etc.
  - c. Sidewalk must be clear of overgrowth from bushes, grasses, branches, etc.
  - d. No visibly dead plants.
- 9. Grass un-kept or overgrown
  - a. Over 4 inches in height.
  - b. Grown over onto sidewalk.
  - c. Grown into cracks in driveway or sidewalk.
  - d. Patches of missing grass.
- 10. Flower beds
  - a. Weeds exceeding 6" in height and covering 25%+ of area.
- 11. Driveways and sidewalks
  - a. Cracked or sunken areas.
  - b. Discoloration

- Mailboxes must be in like-new condition (paint/stain, numbering, materials, etc) and must be upright (no leaning).
- 13. Boats, trailers, commercial vehicles (larger than a standard car or truck), RVs, machinery, or other work equipment.
  - a. May not be stored on the property for longer than 72 continuous hours.
  - b. May not be stored on the property for more than 6 days in one month.
  - c. May not be kept on the grass.
- Commercial vehicles (only a standard car or truck with branding or other modifications)
  - Must be in good visual condition. No excessive rusting, denting, discoloration, etc.
  - b. May not be kept on the grass.
- 15. Tools, equipment, materials, etc
  - a. Must be properly stored and secured and not left in driveway, porch, or lawn.
- 16. Fencing
  - a. Heaving 5%+ of height.
  - b. Leaning or sagging.
  - c. Missing, broken, or discolored boards / sections.
  - d. Needs repaint/stain
  - e. General disrepair.
- 17. Satellite dishes Bylaws 9.2.16 and supplemental language 10/28/97
  - a. Subject to Design Review Committee approval.
  - b. Sized less than one meter across.
  - c. Visually hidden from curb and neighbors.
- 18. Basketball hoops, soccer nets, etc.
  - a. Secured according to manufacturer specifications. No rocks, sand, weights, etc. may be used to hold bases in place.
  - b. Must be in good repair with minimal rusting, denting, discoloration, etc. and no bending or ripped/broken pieces.
